Choices

Andrew and another disciple of John the Baptizer followed Jesus from a distance. Likewise, today there are many long-distance followers of Jesus. Are you close to the Lord? Or are your prayers long-distance calls?

Jesus, who is God, has done what we would consider to be unthinkable. He has become a man. He did even more when He gave to us in the Eucharist the gift to be even closer. He challenges us to look into our hearts and ask ourselves what we are looking for. Jesus, our Rabbi and Teacher, will show us which of these desires are distancing us from Him. All we have to do is give ourselves the chance to hear the truth about our hearts from the Truth Himself. We must stay with Jesus for an extended time. We must not run away when He speaks of changing what we're looking for, repenting of our sins, and taking up the cross daily.

This was the challenge young Samuel had in our first reading. He thought Eli was calling him. But it wasn't. It was God calling. God calls each one of us. He has a plan, a purpose for us. Are we willing to listen and follow His advice or are rejecting it? What about our children? How many times have we asked them, "What do you want to do when you grow up?" Sorry, but what we a Christians really need to ask is, "What do you think GOD want you to do?" This question also applies to us as adults. Sometimes the answer is easy, sometimes it is difficult. Often other people will have reasons for making a different choice. What we really need to do is to seek God's desires. Pray about it. Seek God's will. Jesus did. He prayed many times. Often for hours on end. He prayed all night before selecting his apostles. The world didn't think much of his choices. It still doesn't. I like the following imaginary letter. It is humorous but it also gives us good food for thought. The author is unknown.

MEMO TO: Jesus of Nazareth

FROM: The Jerusalem Management Consulting Firm Dear Sir,

Thank you for submitting the resumes of the 12 men you have picked for management positions in your new organization. All of them have now taken the tests and we have run the results through our computer. We have also conducted in-depth interview with each of them by our staff psychologists and vocational consultants. The results of all the tests are included and you will want to study each of them carefully. It is our opinion that most of your nominees are lacking in the background, education and vocational aptitude for the type of enterprise you are undertaking.
