Fifth Sunday of Lent March 17, 2024

God loves you! He loves you so very, very much. So often we forget that. We get so busy with daily activities that we totally forget about God. This in turn means we forget about Him. No prayer time. No conversation. No seeking His help. Yet God is the One who became man for our sake. He is the One who became all things for us and remains close to us. He cries out to us saying, "See, I am with you all the days of your life." He is our shepherd, the high priest, the way, and the door. He is all things for us at all times.

As we rapidly approach the feast day of Easter, we need to remember that He died, willingly, for us. "Christ has been sacrificed as our Passover." It was Christ who prayed for us saying, "You are my joy!" He came to be with us with joy. We need to be with Him in joy. True joy means we need to cast out wickedness. To achieve this, we must strive to live a life of goodness and be in union with God. This is what the saints have done. In the Old Testament, David rose several times at night to pray to God. Moses, filled with joy, sang His praises for the defeat of Pharaoh and those oppressing the Hebrew people. Others, like Samuel and Elijah, had their hearts filled always with gladness as they performed their duties of worship; it filled their lives. This continues in the New Testament and through today.

St. Patrick, whose feast day is this weekend, gave up his homeland and came to the Irish people to preach the gospels and endure the taunts of unbelievers. He put up with countless persecutions, even bondage and loss of freedom for the sake of others. St. Patrick said, "If I am worthy, I am ready to give up my life, without hesitation and most willingly, for Jesus. I want to spend myself in that country, even in death." St. Patrick said he was deeply in debt to almighty God for all the graces he was given and desired to share them with others. Even those who didn't want to hear him. Other saints, in various ways, have continued to proclaim Jesus and the Father and Holy Spirit in everything they are doing. Seven days a week.

What of the graces we have been given? We are so richly blessed. We have His Words in Sacred Scripture, His sacraments in the Church, and His blessings in our lives. Let us ask Him to help us to bear witness to Him in all our thoughts and actions.
